A bid was received on February 2, 2023, for the demolition of a residential structure located at 40455 NYS Route 180 in the amount of \$16,000.00 from Independent Commercial Contractors Inc. St. Lawrence Engineering also reached out to Joshua David, who previously expressed interest in bidding this project. Mr. David stated that he did not intend to submit a bid.

Based on the bid received, we recommend that Board award the project to Independent Commercial Contractors (ICC). The Town will be responsible for independent air monitoring during the demolition, trucking fill to the site after the demolition, and tipping fees at the Rodman Landfill.
