- 7. Rte. 12 update -Supervisor Rarick spoke to residents to let them know where we are at with project. Dale and Tammy will be doing easements on Thursdays. The project was split into 2 projects for funding purposes. Should break ground in August of 2018. Supervisor Rarick will try to get updates on town website.
- 8. Preconstruction meeting will be June 26th at 10:00 am with funding agencies and contractors at Fourth Coast.
- 9. Collins Landing Sewer update- Rob Campany gave a map and detailed estimate cost would be approximately 1.8 million dollars. Sewer surveys that were sent out came in, yes was the majority vote.

Rob stated that we need to check with funding agencies to see if they will fund project at all. This will only be 34 homes. We need to move along if we are going to do this project. Ideal if we do during water project.

The approximate cost to provide sewer to Farrell Drive and the rest of 12 will be at least \$500,000. Force main is already installed from Clayton project. Supervisor Rarick will send a letter to Farrell Drive residents to see if they are interested in sewer.

- 11. Negotiations- Kevin received letter from union. The board will need to start negotiations. Mary and Pete will help Kevin with negotiations.
- 12. Meeting dates- Town board meeting for July 12th will be at the Fishers Landing Fire Hall. From 6-7 Tammy will notarize easements. Town board meeting to start at 7PM. August meeting will be at the Wellesley Island Fire Department at 7:00PM. September board meeting will be held on Wednesday September 12 because of elections will be held on Thursday September 13th.
- 13. Lee Shimel Comp Plan Lee has had 2 meetings. Next Comp Plan meeting will be held on August 6th at the Fishers Landing Fire Hall. Lee will work on getting surveys out to residents regarding the comprehensive plan. Lee would like to see if the board would set some funds aside for the Comprehensive Plan Committee. Discussion was held.

A motion was made by Mary Ford-Waterman and seconded by Gwen Kirkby to set aside \$2,000 for the comprehensive plan committee.

14. Public Comment- Mike Curtiss stated the Fineview Association would like to see the campgrounds over in Fineview, to be made to clean up the property. Attorney Burrows advised that it is county issue.

Mrs. Parker spoke and would like to see double yellow lines on Reed Point Road.

Bruce Bouthillier owner of Shady Bay trailer park- had sewer problems at one of trailers. He stated Steve Dulmage came to fix problem and then stated he could not fix problem. Steve was instructed by Councilman Johnston not to fix and this is not a town problem. Mr. Bouthillier would like to be reimbursed for the cost of repair, as he stated the town has fixed trailer problems all along for six years. Town board will not reimburse. Attorney Burrows instructed town and Steve Dulmage not fix beyond point of connection this is not towns problem.

WHEREAS, Preliminary Engineering Services, Basic Services, Resident Inspection, and Additional Services have been amended to \$1,670,000; and are to be split into two projects at the request of the Environmental Facilities Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the original Exhibit C Standard hourly rates are for 2013; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Orleans and St. Lawrence Engineering DPC agree that Amendment No.3 to the Agreement for Engineering Services between St. Lawrence Engineering and the Town of Orleans shall amend the Technical Services agreement amount of \$1,670,000.00 be split into two projects of \$1,503,000 (Collection System) and \$167,000 (Water Storage Tank) at the request of Environmental Facilities Corporation for the purposes of funding, and the standard hourly rates has been updated to the 2018 hourly rate schedule.
