Route 12 Water Project Fact Sheet
September 2018

Construction has started! As you may have seen, the pipeline contractor, North Country Contractors, has received many deliveries of pipe and fittings and have placed them in various areas throughout the project site. The following is a tentative schedule of work:

- Installation of water mains along roads will take place during the months of September, October, November in the following areas:
 - Seaway Avenue
 - Collins Landing Road from Seaway Avenue to TIBA Maintenance Shop (greenhouses)
- Installation of service connections to individual homes are tentatively scheduled on Seaway Avenue during November and December, depending on weather and overall construction conditions. Individual homeowners will be contacted to coordinate service connection schedule and location.
- A winter shutdown may occur depending on weather conditions.
- Work from Grass Point State Park to Fishers Landing is currently scheduled for 2019.
- Water Tank and Pumping Station construction at intersection of Route 12 and Seaway Avenue Scheduled for summer 2019.
- Construction Completion scheduled for Summer 2020

Additional Important Project Details:

- Remaining easements for property owners wishing to be connected during the construction will continue to be

received. If you have not received an easement or have questions, please contact the Town at 315.658.9950. If an easement is not obtained from a property owner, it will be assumed they do not want service.

- The contractor will connect to your existing water service outside the home. Any modifications to plumbing inside the home or to the existing well are the homeowner's responsibility.

- Estimated Residential User Costs as follows:
 - Fixed Charge approximately \$525/year
 - Variable water use charge estimated at \$175 per year per EDU. Actual charge will vary depending on cost of water purchased from Village of Alexandria Bay and Town of Alexandria Pumping charges
 - No hookup fees for property owners if hookup completed as part of project. The property owner will be responsible for all costs associated with connecting to the system after the project is complete. A fixed user charge will be assessed to those not connected to the system but within the Water District Boundary with the ability to connect in the future.
