RESOLUTION #5 EASEMENT FROM THE NYS DEC

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Orleans serves as the governing Board for the Orleans Water District #2 also known as Town of Orleans New York State Route 12 Water District and which consists of several hundred parcels; and

WHEREAS, formation of the Water District was intended to enable development that would enable the Town to provide potable water to residents within the Water District; and

WHEREAS, the installation, maintenance, and repair, of water main(s) and other infrastructure upon parcels within the Water District is necessary in order to achieve the purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Orleans seeks to acquire a permanent easement of twenty (20) feet in width (10 feet on either side of water mains(s)) to be installed and a temporary easement of twenty (20) feet total width (10 feet on either side of permanent easement) to allow for the installation of a water main(s) across the lands of the affected property owners; and

WHEREAS, New York State Department of Environmental Conservation is the record owner of lands at Collins Landing Wildlife Management Area (WMA) identified as Tax Parcel # 13.06-1-31 within the District (the subject property); and

WHEREAS, the subject property is within the water district and upon which installation of a water main is needed in order to provide public water to residents within the district.

NOW THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the easement to be sought from the NYS DEC is attached as Exhibit A and is incorporated herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Town Officials, Town Attorneys, and Town Engineers are hereby authorized to seek, prepare, and execute all documents which may be required to obtain a necessary easement from the NYS DEC for those purposes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
