





RESOLUTION #15 SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING IN CONNECTION WITH THE EXERCISE OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO ACQUIRE EASEMENTS FROM PROPERTY OWNERS RELATED TO THE NYS ROUTE 12 WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Orleans, New York previously formed NYS Route 12 Water District associated with a Water Distribution Project that will serve residents in the Route 12 corridor from the Route 81 interchange to the Town of Clayton line; and

WHEREAS, the Water Distribution Project will serve approximately 390 homes and approximately 30 business with abundant potable water; and

WHEREAS, approximately 200 parcels are classified "critical" in that easements across those parcels would include a Water Main vital for the provision of public water to all affected properties in the District; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Orleans, New York believes it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Town to continue to provide public water to all effected parcels for the health, safety and welfare of all residents within the District;

WHEREAS, nearly 200 owners of "critical" parcels have provided the necessary easement to enable the Water Distribution Project to proceed; and

WHEREAS, the record owners of 10 critical parcels have refused and/or declined and/or neglected to provide the necessary easement to the Town of Orleans to enable the Water Distribution Project to proceed; and

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RESOLUTION-PublicMeeting-EminentDomain-12Water

WHEREAS, the Eminent Domain Procedure Law is the exclusive procedure by which real property may be acquired to exercise the power of Eminent Domain in New York State; and

WHEREAS, Article 2 of the Eminent Domain Procedure Law requires that a condemner, prior to acquisition, and in order to inform the public and to review the public use to be served by a proposed public project and its impact on the environment and residents of the locality were such projects will be constructed, must conduct a public hearing at a location reasonably approximate to the property that may be acquired; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Orleans, on behalf of the Town of Orleans, as condemner, contemplates the acquisition of easements to be acquired and dedicated as a right-of-way for Water Mains and Fire Hydrants to be necessary and which are currently owned by the record owners of such parcels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Orleans shall hold a public hearing at the Town Hall of the Town of Orleans at 20558 Sunrise Avenue, LaFargeville, New York on Monday, November 27th, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. for purposes of informing the public concerning, and reviewing the public use to be served by, the proposed acquisition of easements to real property located within the Water District; each parcel is currently owned by:
