To Fully Participate in Any Article 10 Application To Site Major Electric Generating Facilities in **Town of Orleans**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Orleans, New York is aware that Atlantic Wind, LLC and/or other potential persons might proceed with an application seeking approval to site a major electric generating facilities via Article 10 of the Public Service Commission Law, located, in part at least, within the boundaries of the Town of Orleans; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Orleans is empowered to safeguard the health, safety, and welfare of the public within the boundaries of Town of Orleans, New York; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that it is best suited to safeguard the interests of the public in connection with the potential siting of a major electric generating facilities within the Town of Orleans if the Town participates to the maximum extent possible, throughout the Article 10 review.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Orleans , New York shall seek to participate to the maximum extent possible as a party in respect to any pre-application or application hereafter submitted to the NY Board on Electric Generation siting and the environment as authorized by Article 10 of the Public Service Law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor of the Town of Orleans and its agents, officers, and attorneys shall take all steps reasonably necessary to fully participate in that process.
